
## Lizzie Devaney ( 8 April 1904) and John Tarrant (23 December 1897)

Lizzie Devaney was born in Northwich, Cheshire on the 8<sup>th</sup> April, 1904. Her father had died before she was born and her mother was forced into domestic service. Sadly, Lizzie's mother took her older daughter, Kate with her but Lizzie was sent to a workhouse. She was raised at the workhouse and an orphanage and eventually went into domestic service.

John Tarrant was born on the 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 1898 in Galway. Hs occupation was a public works labourer.


Lizzie and John married in 1926, when Lizzie was 22 and John, 27. They had no children. Lizzie died in 1992 and John in 1972.





Lizzie was undoubtedly a strong personality, born on a completely Yang Day, with Yang elements also in her Month and Year Pillars. This would also have translated into a strong physical constitution. A person born on a Yang Water Monkey day appears strong and purposeful and easily commands trust and respect from others. They tend to be resilient and can blend in and adapt in difficult or unfamiliar situations. They are blessed with intuition, coupled with the ability to gather information, size up situations and then act when the time is right. Internally, they can become secretive but respond well to people willing to take the time to listen to them. Lizzie would have been a capable and loyal employee, ever ready to show initiative and go the extra mile to finish the job. John had a combination between his Month and Year Pillars that would have given him an affinity with educational matters. As this relates to his work and his wider community it would be interesting to know if he was involved in community education. Despite his gentle nature he may well have been involved in teaching or public speaking, quite confident standing on the stage. People with this combination of elements do not have the need to follow all the rules and can be street smart and creative.

We don't know how Lizzie and John met but their birth charts give some clues. A smart, capable woman like Lizzie was always going to find a partner — she has spouse elements in her Day, Month and Year. It is likely she met John either at work or within their wider community. They do share a combination in their Year pillars that suggest a strong affinity with each other within the wider community. John, as we have already seen, may well have been focused much more on this role and relationships with friends and the wider community. Their relationship was likely built on mutual trust and support. In BaZi, the Nobleman Star is an influence that brings help in time of need. Every person has two Noblemen Stars but they do not always appear in the chart. John and Lizzie share one of each other's Nobleman stars in their relationship pillar. Lizzie's Monkey is a Nobleman to John and John's Rabbit is a Nobleman to Lizzie. It is not surprising their marriage lasted so many years.
